



AGRICULTURE AND FOOD AUTHORITY COFFEE DIRECTORATE

1) Coffee liquorer's licensing requirements

- a) Been awarded a coffee liquoring certificate by the Authority.
- b) Obtain a public hygiene certificate from the nearest local authority to the area of operation.
- c) Submit application to the Authority.
- d) Meet any other qualification that may be prescribed by the Authority;

2) Coffee liquoring /cupping facility requirements

1. Names of company officials, individual National ID/Passport No.
2. A certified copy of certificate of incorporation/business name.
3. Establishment of standard facilities as specified by the Authority.- to be developed
4. Proof of engaging the services of a coffee liquorer licensed by the Authority.
5. Compliance with statutory requirements, including but not limited to—
 - a) NEMA certificate where applicable;
 - b) Occupational Health and Safety Certificate, (OHSA) where applicable
 - c) Public Health certificate;
 - d) Tax Compliance certificate by KRA.
6. Self-declaration of any indebtedness, conflicts and litigations within the coffee industry.
7. Any other requirements that may be prescribed by the Authority from time to time
